# Statewide Athlete Leadership Council- Term of 2 years

- Meets 10 time per year via virtual calls (7) and in-person meetings (3)
  - o Virtual calls: second Monday of each month at 6PM-7PM

    - March and July Headquarters Office, Albany, NY
    - October State Fall Games
    - No meeting February and June

# Year 1: Practical Application

1st Quarter: Review expectations and operations guide, elections for chair, vice chair, secretary, Goal setting, Getting to know each other

2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter: Leading discussions on Unified Leadership at the region ALC level and choice of elective

3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter: Preparation to host press conference and/or public event, Refine and present your story

4th Quarter: Exploring job options (guest presenter) and choice of elective

# Year 2: Personal and Professional Development

1st Quarter: Review of previous year course materials, choice of elective

2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter: Leadership track opportunities; Athlete Representative, Sport Leaders,

Health Messenger, Event Coordinator, Global Messenger

3rd Quarter: Selection and implementation of leadership track; Athlete Representative,

Sport Leaders (coach, official) Health Messenger, Event Coordinator, Global

Messenger, Board of Directors Service

4th Quarter: Graduation and emeritus election (1 athlete, 1 year term)

#### Curriculum:

Core coursework will consist of SOI materials and electives.

Coursework including:

- Governmental Awareness
- Involvement in Special Olympics programming
- How to become a Coach-Official
- How to enhance your local program
- Understanding sport management
- Understanding event management
- Specific initiatives; health program, young athletes

## Voting:

Various organizational matters will be brought to the ALC for discussion and voting



# Tracking:

Who: Volunteer coordinator, OER

What: Quarterly reporting will consist of courses/electives completed, number of athletes trained and opportunities presented to athletes to execute training (speaking engagements, planning of local fundraisers, volunteering at program events, etc.) Where: tracking form (developed by OER)

ALC Timeline: using 2022 start year as example 2022- Statewide Council, 1 year for current class 2022 - Regional ALC program starts officially 2023 - Regional Councils-push new members up to statewide council 2023 - Statewide new class starts
