

Alpine Skiing Volunteer Information

Parking: Please park in the main parking lot of the ski mountain. There is no designated parking for volunteers.

Check-In: Upon arrival, please report to the building's Acropolis Room. Check in at the volunteer registration table.

COVID-19 vaccination is **not** required to volunteer at these games. However, if you are vaccinated, please let us know for our rate records.

If you pre-registered online, give your name and show your ID to be checked in. If you have not been able to pre-register, be prepared to fill out volunteer paperwork and show your ID.

Please make sure to get a Special Olympics NY credential and write your name on it. This is used to identify each of the volunteers.

Training: After you are all checked in and have your credential, training is on-site.

Description: Swish! Get in on the ski slope action by filling needs such as race starters, announcer, timing coordinators, athlete escorts, finish line attendants, and others needs as determined at the event. We need both on-mountain and off-mountain volunteers. Ski/Snowboard equipment required for some volunteer jobs. Please make sure to dress warm including hat, gloves, boots, winter coat, etc.

Qualifications: Ability to perform assigned duties for the duration of the competition, be flexible with assignments and able to be on your feet for stretches of time. Experience in alpine skiing preferred. Level of experience will determine job placement.

Lunch is not provided- please bring a bag lunch with you or lunch will be available for purchase from venue concession stands.
