Cycling Volunteer Information

Parking: Do NOT use the main entrance to the Municipal Center. All vehicles must enter from the Glen Lake Rd direction off of Rte 9. Park in the lot on the side of the Human Services Building (not on the side with the tents and finish line).



Check-In: Head to the other side of the building and check in at the volunteer registration table. If you pre-registered online, give your name and show your ID to be checked in. If you have not been able to pre-register, be prepared to fill out volunteer paperwork and show your ID. Please make sure to get a Special Olympics NY credential and write your name on it. This is used to identify each of the volunteers.

Training: After you are all checked in and have your credential, training is on-site.

Description: We won't ask you to bike, but you are needed to assist at the start/athlete staging, timing, marshalling, finish line, lunch escorts and other needs as determined at the event. When competition is complete, volunteers will help take down the Finish line trellis, clean up the venue, and load the UHaul with equipment.

Lunch is not provided- please bring a bag lunch with you.

Qualifications: A can-do, flexible attitude with ability to be on your feet for stretches of time. For breakdown, some tasks will require heavy lifting of 25 pounds or more.
