Check-In: Head inside and you'll see Volunteer Check-In next to the main desk.

If you pre-registered online, give your name and show your ID to be checked in. If you have not been able to pre-register, be prepared to fill out volunteer paperwork and show your ID. Please make sure to get a Special Olympics NY credential and write your name on it. This is used to identify each of the volunteers.

Training: After you are checked in and have your credential, training is on-site.

Description: We won't ask to see your lutz or toe loop, but volunteers are needed to escort and stage athletes, assist athletes on/off the ice, and other needs as determined at the event. Please keep in mind that our skaters are very skilled, so at times, volunteers may not be the most hands-on. We encourage volunteers to take this opportunity to connect with and support our athletes. A lively fan section provides a truly meaningful experience for each skater.

Qualifications: A can-do, flexible attitude with ability to be on your feet for stretches of time.
